Демонстрационный вариант предназначен для того, чтобы дать возможность любому участнику промежуточной аттестации составить представление о структуре работы промежуточной аттестации, количестве и форме заданий, а также об их уровне сложности.

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Инструкция по выполнению работы

Работа промежуточной аттестации по английскому языку состоит из двух разделов, включающих в себя 20 заданий.

На выполнение заданий промежуточной аттестации отводится 45 минут (один урок), включая инструктаж и раздачу заданий.

Раздел 1 (задания по чтению) включает 5 заданий на установление соответствия заголовков текстам и 5 заданий на установление истинности высказываний на основе прочитанного текста.

Раздел 2 (лексико-грамматические задания) включает 10 заданий с выбором одного правильного ответа из четырех предложенных.

Ответы к заданиям 1-5 записываются в виде букв, обозначающих заголовки. Ответы к заданиям 6-20 записываются в виде цифры, которая соответствует номеру правильного ответа.

При выполнении заданий можно пользоваться черновиком.

Баллы, полученные Вами за выполненные задания, суммируются. Постарайтесь выполнить как можно больше заданий и набрать наибольшее количество баллов.

Рекомендуется выполнять задания в том порядке, в котором они даны.

Раздел 1. Чтение

В заданиях 1-5 определите, какой из приведенных вариантов заголовков соответствует содержанию текста. Запишите букву выбранного вами варианта ответа.

1 Заголовок текста – _____

The oldest building on the territory of the Tower is the White Tower. This is where the kings of England once ate, slept and ran the country. Strangely enough, the first person to live in the palace in the White Tower, in 1100, was not a king but a prisoner (узник). He soon escaped down a rope (по веревке) from an upper window. Later kings made the Tower larger and stronger and built walls, a moat (ров), smaller and more comfortable palaces. The last palace built in the Tower was the Queen's House. It was probably built for the second wife of Henry the VIII.

2 Заголовок текста – _____

Charles II liked looking at the stars. So he had an observatory built in the White Tower. One day the king was looking through his telescope when a raven flew over him and ploп (шлеп) — you guessed! Charles was so angry that he decided to get rid of the ravens. But someone warned him that it would be very unlucky, so he let them stay and moved his observatory to Greenwich.

3 Заголовок текста – _____

During the troubled times of Tudors and Stuarts (Тюдоры и Стюарты) many kings, queens and noblemen (аристократы) were locked up in the Tower. Many, like lady Jane Grey or Ann Boleyn, lost their heads on Tower Green. These executions were private. But over a hundred other prisoners were executed on Tower Hill, outside the Tower. These executions were public, watched by thousands of people who mostly came for the excitement. During the Second World War German spies (шпионы) were kept in the Tower and sometimes shot there.

4 Заголовок текста – _____

The Jewel House at the Tower of London is the home of the most valuable collection of jewels in the world, the Crown Jewels (королевские драгоценности). They are well looked after. Once they were stolen by a man called Colonel Blood. But he was caught just as he was leaving the Tower. Thomas Blood didn't have to go to prison. The king gave him a pension instead.

5 Заголовок текста – _____

Kings sometimes get strange presents. About 700 years ago King Henry III got 3 leopards, an elephant and a polar bear. He kept them in the Tower. The elephant died after two years but the polar bear was happy as it went swimming and fishing in the Thames with a strong rope round its neck. In 1835 all animals left the Tower and were sent to Regent's Park. Only the ravens stayed on. They are not friendly. Once one of the ravens bit a German minister. But there is a story that they bring good luck to Britain if they stay at the Tower. That's why they get meat and biscuits every day.

He came home at 7 o'clock that evening, and when he had eaten his supper, he went into his bedroom and looked at the mirror. 'That silly woman still hasn't cleaned it!' he said to himself. 'All it needs is a cloth!'

But then he bent down and saw a bottle in front of the mirror. 'I didn't put that bottle there,' he thought. 'Mrs Smith must have left it.' He picked the bottle up and looked at it carefully.
